AUDIENCE Workers at all levels whose work routines involve some level of mobility

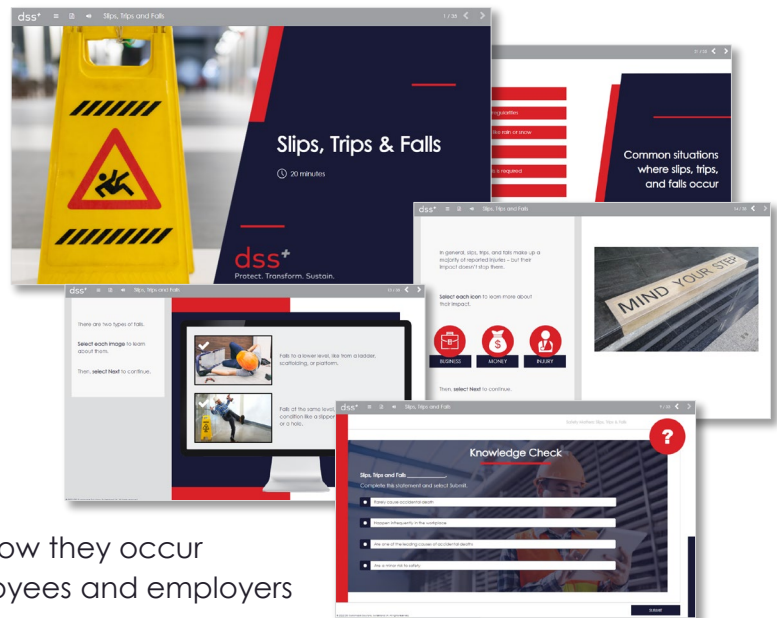
